

**AN ACT**

1 AMENDING SECTIONS 4-1-1 AND 4-8-3 OF THE 2016-2017 ASNMSU LAWBOOK. BE IT ENACTED BY  
2 THE SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

9 4-1-1 DEFINITIONS

10 As used in the ASNMSU Open Meeting Act:

11

12 A. "Policy-making body" means any ASNMSU board, committee, or other body that recommends or formulates  
13 policy[;], including the development of personnel policy, rules, regulations, discussing public business or for the  
14 purpose of taking any action of the authority of or the delegated authority ASNMSU[, but ] Although this is not  
15 limited to the ASNMSU Senate Committees, [the ASNMSU Publications and Communications Board, ]the  
16 ASNMSU Activities Committee, the Intramural Policy Board and the ASNMSU Senate;

20 4-8-3 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE

21 The ASNMSU Law Book Committee is hereby authorized to:

22

23 A. "Policy-making body" means any ASNMSU board, committee or other body that recommends or formulates  
24 policy, including the development of personnel policy, rules, regulations, discussing public business [orfor] or for  
25 the purpose of taking any action of the authority of or the delegated authority ASNMSU, but not limited to the  
26 ASNMSU Senate Committees, the ASNMSU Publications and Communications Board, the ASNMSU Activities  
27 Committee, the Intramural Policy Board and the ASNMSU Senate;

29 B. Determine whether the requirements of the Law Book have been met in accordance with the ASNMSU laws, rules  
30 and regulations of NMSU and to file a certificate with the Vice President of Student Affairs of NMSU when the  
31 foregoing provisions have been met to the effect that the Law Book shall be recognized as the official law of  
32 ASNMSU as of the date of publication;

34 C. Adopt any system of codification deemed necessary or useful.

36 D.Law Book Committee shall meet at least once each academic year prior to the beginning of the fall semester. This  
37 meeting shall be scheduled by the ASNMSU Vice President.

39 Section 3: Rationale

40

41 These amendments, made during the Fall Session of the ASNMSU Lawbook Committee serve to: allow  
42 sentences to flow better for easier reading, remove a Board that no longer exists to remain accurate, and  
43 allow the Lawbook Committee to meet more than once a year to ensure the Lawbook is being updated as  
44 needed.
