25 Section 3: Appropriation.

Two thousand five hundred fifty-eight dollars and sixty-three cents (\$2558.63) shall be appropriated to the account
27 of Community Outreach from the ASNMSU Surplus Account.

29 Section 4: Rationale.

30

In order to be comply with NMSU Payroll Policy, adjustments must be made for legal reasons to the
31 Assistant Director compensation. Following the wage adjustments, the Community Outreach department
32 has produced an itemized budget of projected shortfalls for the year. Out of State Conference is for the Big
33 Event Conference that must be attended every year at TTU. This funding was cut from the GAA because
34 the entire amount was not used. This was mistakenly assumed to be because the funding was excessive and
35 unnecessary, when in fact it was because the previous director had secured grant funding for the travel. The
36 Exec will attempt to acquire similar funding this year, but it is not guaranteed. This funding would ensure

37 our ability to attend. The in-state travel will be used to attend the NMASC, which is the high school student
38 government conference for NM SGA's. CO would like to attend to promote the Roadrunner program to
39 those students. Lastly, CO's Roadrunner funding has steadily declined from \$5000 three years ago to \$1000
40 in the current GAA. This is not enough to hold the traditional Roadie Splash and Dash event, and this
41 money would allow for them to host the event once again.
