4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To provide funding for one student (1 female) to perform community service in Seoul, South Korea from December
6 18, 2016 to January 4, 2017.

25 Four hundred seventy-seven dollars and no cents (\$477.00) shall be appropriated to the account of Black Students
26 Association from the ASNMSU Surplus Account.

28 Section 4: Rationale.

29 Rose Vidal is going to Seoul, South Korea to assist former "comfort women" by cleaning for them,
30 shopping with them, assisting in home maintenance and other duties. By going to Korea, Rose will be
31 representing New Mexico State University in an international effort to shed light on the horrific
32 experiences that these women have endured. The experiences that Korean women endured during Imperial
33 Japan's occupation of the peninsula are similar to ongoing occurrences in Africa, such as the kidnapping of
34 women and girls by the terrorist organization Boko Haram.
