AN ACT

1 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ACCOUNT OF EXECUTIVE. BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE
2 ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To supplement funding for the ASNMSU Executive Account in order to compensate ASNMSU Executive Staff
6 members who routinely work more than 20 hours a week during Fiscal Year 2016 - 2017.

24 Section 3: Appropriation.

25 Seven thousand one hundred forty dollars and thirty-one cents (\$7141.31) shall be appropriated to the account of
26 Executive from the ASNMSU Surplus Account.

28 Section 4: Rationale.

29 During a September 2016 meeting of the ASNMSU President, ASNMSU Fiscal Advisor (NMSU Business
30 Manager, I), ASNMSU Advisor, the NMSU Vice President of Student Affairs and Enrollment
31 Management, the NMSU Dean of Students, NMSU Business Manager, III, and the NMSU Assistant Vice
32 President of Human Resources, it was established that ASNMSU employees who routinely worked more
33 than the standard 20 hours a week needed to be properly compensated for the extra hours of work, as
34 established by the Fair Labor Standards Act and regulated by the United States Department of Labor. In
35 order to comply with federal, state and university regulations, the ASNMSU President and Chief of Staff

36 positions, whose duties regularly require their incumbents to work more than 20 hours per week, required
37 legislation supplementing their compensation to include potential pay for an additional work period not to
38 exceed 10 hours (30 total) per week.
