1 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ACCOUNT OF NMSU COLLEGIATE FFA. BE IT ENACTED BY THE  
2 SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To provide funding for seven students (2 males, 5 females) to compete at the FFA National Convention and Expo in  
6 Indianapolis, IN from October 18-22, 2016.
