A RESOLUTION

1 CONCERNING THE PENDING ACQUISITION OF A LIQUOR LICENSE FOR CORBETT
2 CENTER STUDENT UNION.

4 WHEREAS, alcoholic beverages and liquors are a legal, regulated, and a governmentally
5 controlled substance; and

6

7 WHEREAS, the 1984 National Minimum Drinking Age Act prohibits persons under 21 years of
8 age from purchasing or publicly possessing alcoholic beverages; and

10 WHEREAS, the Pan American Center, 3rd Floor Bistro, NMSU Aggie Memorial Stadium, and
11 Presley Askew Baseball Field all serve alcoholic beverages, responsibly, in conjunction with
12 Sodexo; and

13

14 WHEREAS, the acquirement of a governmental liquor license for the Corbett Student Union
15 would follow suit with other four year institutions around New Mexico that provide alcoholic
16 beverages for their respective student unions; and

18 WHEREAS, the acquirement of a governmental liquor license for the Corbett Student Union
19 would give students a convenient and safe location to drink alcoholic beverages; and

21 WHEREAS, as a student body, we are aware of the culture surrounding binge drinking and
22 college students. We believe with the right amount of education and proper procedures, this may
23 be avoided; and

24

25 WHEREAS, we believe it is important to have a location on campus that may serve as a hub for
26 NMSU athletics when they are competing on the road; and

27

28 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Associated Students of New Mexico State
29 University believes the acquisition of a liquor license and the potential creation of a Pub for the Corbett
30 Center Student Union would be a good addition to the student life at the Corbett Center Student Union,
31 providing a location that students may indulge in adult beverages while remaining on campus.

33BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an advisory board be established to oversee the effects of a liquor
34license in the Corbett Center Student Union. This board shall be comprised of the ASNMSU President, a
35representative of the ASNMSU Senate, two representatives from WAVE, and no fewer than three other
36at-large students appointed by the ASNMSU President. The board shall be tasked with overseeing any
37major incidents as a direct result of the addition of the liquor license. This board shall serve as the
38recommending body to Chancellor of NMSU on matters concerning the liquor license in the Corbett
39Center Student Union.

40

41BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any potential pub service place very strict serving requirements to
42prevent any potential abuse of alcohol.

43

44BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the use of two forms of identification be mandatory practice to be
45served inside the potential pub.

46

47BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sodexo in conjunction with the department of HRTM place an
48academic focus on the operations of any potential pub, providing these students with an opportunity to
49gain valuable hand-on experience.

50

51BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Associated Students of New Mexico State University believe that
52it would be a good employment opportunity for students enrolled in the university.

53

54BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a percentage of the profits from the potential pub be put back into the Corbett
55Center Student Union for future repairs, renovations or initiatives.

57BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies be sent to the President of New Mexico State University, the
58Executive Vice President and Provost of New Mexico State University, the Dean of Students, Dr. Michael Jasek,
59the Sodexo General Manager, Mr. Dwayne Wisniewski, the President of the Associated Students of New Mexico
60State University, the Senators of the Associated Students of New Mexico State University, and the student media
61organizations of New Mexico State University.
