




Wage adjustments are listed first. Next, and most pressingly, is the purchase of a 6-person golf cart. In the past fiscal year alone, \$12000 was spent on repairs to the three aging carts. The executive cart has once again stopped working and the repairs will, again, be substantial. In an effort to reduce maintenance cost, we would like to trade in the two oldest carts (the executive cart which is nearing 10 years and the older Pete's Pickup cart which is 5 years old) and replace them with only one cart. After trade in value, the price for the cart would be \$10,000. This would be the first six person cart we own, as a direct result of students who utilize the Pete's Pickup service requesting larger carts so groups of students can all be taken in one ride. This investment would prove immediately valuable, as it would reduce repairs costs from the current

37 \$12000 a year to less than \$2000. Next, an increase in the contractual services budget is requested to
38 implement President Bose's initiative to have a trial run partnership with Corbett for a nap room. Corbett
39 would pay to staff the area and provide equipment such as cotts, sleeping bags, etc. . . and ASNMSU would
40 provide branded linens and sleep masks.
