

1 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ACCOUNT OF ENGAGENM. BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE  
2 ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

5 To provide funding for two students (1 female, 1 male) to perform community service in Rabat, Morocco from  
6 December 9, 2016 – January 1, 2017.
