26 Four hundred eighty-two dollars and no cents (\$482.00) shall be appropriated to the account of Water Science and
27 Management Graduate Student Organization from the ASNMSU Surplus Account.

29 Section 4: Rationale.

30 Constance (Connie) Maxwell is applying for funding to present at the 9th International Symposium on Managed
31 Aquifer Recharge in Mexico City, Mexico from June 20-24, 2016. They are requesting funds for airfare from
32 Albuquerque as they live closer to Albuquerque than El Paso. They presented their paper, "Supporting agro-
33 ecological resiliency through managed aquifer recharge practices in the Southwestern United States". Their work
34 focuses on NM's agricultural communities and the ecologies upon which they rely, through increasing the ability for
35 agriculture to be a system for water recharge in New Mexico.
