36 Section 4: Rationale.

37 Lillian Calhoun, Carley Casey, Stephanie Clark, Noelia De la Rosa, Brianna Dever, Rachel Hubly,
38 Dantong Lu, Lakken Medina, Hannah Nichols, Hannah O'Hara, Alexis Puente, Alyssa Robinson and
39 Serena Robinson will be competing at the American Dance Association – Baja Region at El Camino
40 Community College in Torrance, California, a suburb of Los Angeles about 40 miles south of downtown.
41 This competition will allow these students to showcase months of preparation and hard work and exemplify
42 NMSU's excellence, as they compete for one of 10-12 spots at the Gala Concert on the final night of the
43 event. This concert is the highest honor the dancers can receive and the NMSU performers will be critically
44 judged by a panel of adjudicators, who will judge them on their choreography, style and the overall quality
45 of their performance. The NMSU performers will additionally take part in four (4) days of mandatory
46 workshops with dance teachers, artists from other universities, and acclaimed guests. This is a rare
47 opportunity for the performers to compete in an out of conference event on a mega-stage like Los Angeles
48 and gain new and invaluable insight, experience and knowledge of the professional dance world in an
49 environment outside of their normal South-South Conference.
