

1 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ACCOUNT OF NMSU STUDENT CHAPTER OF NATIONAL SOCIETY OF
2 PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS AND NM PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS. BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF
3 THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

7 Geospatial Conference in Silver Spring, MD, from March 12 - 16, 2017.

32 NMSU Student Chapter of National Society of Professional Surveyors and NM Professional Surveyors from the
33 ASNMSU Surplus Account.

35 Section 4: Rationale.

36 Garrett Smelker, Adalberto Guerrero, Julian Heckman, Laura Hardin, and Felice Vigil-Mora competed at
37 the National Surveying, Mapping, & Geospatial Conference in Silver Spring, MD. This competition will
38 allow the students to show their specific approach to the topic of high-precision vertical control
39 applications. This opportunity also allowed the students to establish channels of communication with other
40 national organizations as well as network with other surveying and geomatics students from across the
41 nation. The competition allows the participants an opportunity to share information, knowledge and tools,
42 as well as facilitate collaboration on data acquisition.
