






Five thousand five hundred thirty dollars and seventy-eight cents (\$5530.78) shall be appropriated to the account of

Vice President from the ASNMSU Surplus Account.

25 Section 4: Rationale.

Following the wage adjustment, Vice President Prieto would like to host a second retreat in the Spring

Semester. Lodging expenses consume almost half of the entire annual budget allotted for Retreats for the

fall semester alone. The requested amount would be aimed towards expanding the team building activities

29

during the retreat. Furthermore, with the current unadjusted budget, the spring semester retreat will not be

30

able to be held outside of the city.
