

AN ACT

1 AMENDING SECTIONS 5-2-7, 5-4, AND 5-9 OF THE 2017- 2018 ASNMSU LAW BOOK. BE IT ENACTED BY THE  
2 SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To update and clarify Chapter 5 of the ASNMSU Law Book in accordance with the recommendations of the  
6 Summer 2017 Law Book Committee. Amended with deleted material [in brackets] and inserted material underlined:

8 Section 2: Main Provisions.

10 **5-2-7. SALARY**

11

12 The ASNMSU Chief Justice shall receive a salary not to exceed the current applicable minimum wage (as  
13 allowed for by Title [51] 29 of the US Code) plus the ASNMSU minimum wage adjustment factor of  
14 eighty (80) hours per month while performing the duties of the office. This salary may not be reduced  
15 during the term of a Chief Justice. ASNMSU Associate Justices shall receive a salary not to exceed the  
16 current applicable minimum wage (as allowed for by [t]Title [51] 29 of the US Code) plus the ASNMSU  
17 minimum wage adjustment factor of forty (40) hours per month while performing the duties of the office.  
18 This salary may not be reduced during the term of an Associate Justice.

22 **[5-4. ASNMSU SUPREME COURT CLERK**

27 **5-4-5. SALARY**

The Supreme Court Clerk shall receive a salary not to exceed one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per month while

29 performing the duties of the office.]
