36 Cheerleading camp gives the team the opportunity to receive a bronze, silver or gold paid bid to their
37 national competition. NM State Cheer was one of 3 teams to receive a gold paid bid, which not only allows

them to attend the national competition but to compete at the elite DIA level and will pay for 5 hotel rooms. The team competed in both the Rally and Game Day Routine, receiving the gold paid bid. The Pistol Petes also received a bid to be the first human form mascots to ever compete at NCA Collegiate nationals in the mascot division.
