28 Ryland Carter, Mason Salcido, Fernando Contreras, and Ethan Holbrook attended the Biennial Conclave in Las  
29 Vegas from the 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> of July where they participated in seminars that focused on leadership training,  
30 recruitment and philanthropic planning as well as brotherhood development and living the ritual. Conclave brought  
31 together over 1,500 undergraduate and alumni members throughout the United States and Canada to elect a new  
32 national executive board. The Nu Epsilon Chapter (NMSU) of Kappa Sigma was recognized and received the top  
33 two awards in the country- The Founders Award of Chapter Excellence and the Founders Circle Award.
