

36 Section 4: Rationale.

37 Sajia Afrin Ema is applying for funding to attend the American Society of Mechanical Engineers IMEC
38 2017 in Tampa, Florida, from November 3-9. They request includes the conference registration fee, 3
39 nights of hotel accommodations, and airfare to and from the conference. They are Ph.D. student in the
40 Department of Industrial Engineering at NMSU main campus. They have registered to attend this
41 conference to present their poster titled as *An Optimization Model and its Application in Operating Room*
42 *Scheduling*. In this study, they have developed a Decision Support System (DSS) for hospital management
43 that would aid them to take the optimal decisions to share the surgical units among different classes of
44 patients in a cost effective and safer way. The DSS have been tested on data for a case study hospital in
45 Bangladesh.
