AN ACT

1 AMENDING SECTIONS 2-8-1-O, 2-8-1-P AND 4-2-7-A-1 OF THE 2017-2018 ASNMSU LAW BOOK. BE IT
2 ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

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4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To update and amend the Law Book to have the deadline for the submission of candidate violation forms during
6 elections, and have the Qualification/Check Release form deadlines for Candidates running for office or appointed
7 to a Senate vacant seat by their college council.

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9 Section 2: Main Provisions.

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2. ELECTION CODE

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2-8. CAMPAIGN RULES

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2-8-1. GENERAL RULES

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O. All candidates shall submit the list serve form by five (5:00) pm the first day of voting, financial disclosure forms by five (5:00) pm on the final day of voting, and the Violation form [at the discretion of the Chief Elections Officer] by five thirty (5:30) pm on the final day of voting in order to accommodate for potential last-minute violations, to the office of the Chief Elections Officer.

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P. All candidates shall submit the Qualification/Check Release form, at the discretion of the Chief Elections Officer, to the office of the Chief Elections Officer.

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4. LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

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4-2. SENATE VACANCY ACTS

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4-2-7. VALIDITY OF APPOINTMENT

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A. Approve each appointment by a majority of a quorum of the college council membership in accordance with the council's constitution and by-laws;

1. The approved interim Senator must submit to the ASNMSU Vice President the Qualification/Check Release form, in order to be sworn in.

Section 3: Rationale.

2-8-1-O: The purpose of this amendment is to set a deadline for the submission of the candidate violation forms during elections. This deadline shall be five thirty (5:30) pm on the final day of voting in order to accommodate for potential last-minute violations.

2-8-1-P: The purpose of this amendment is to have a deadline for the Qualification/Check Release form in the Law Book.

4-2-7-A-1: This section is being amended to require that senators that are appointed to a vacant seat submit their Qualification/Check Release form to the ASNMSU Vice President prior to being sworn in.
