



AN ACT

1 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ACCOUNT OF JAZZ CLUB NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY. BE IT  
2 ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To provide funding for 23 students (16 males, 7 females) to perform community service in Valencia, Spain from  
6 June 23 – July 1, 2018.

32 Valencia, Spain. The director at the Music Conservatory, Vicente Campos, has arranged this opportunity  
33 for intercultural exchange between NMSU students and music students in Valencia. Jazz is not a genre of  
34 music that is typically taught in Europe and this endeavor represents a perfect way to share our musical  
35 culture and will reflect very well upon the university and the music department.
