32 and Noah Pierce competed at the Associated Schools of Construction Student Competition from February 7-10 in  
33 Reno Nevada. Six of these students competed in a bid/ scheduling competition in the Heavy Civil Bid Competition.

35 State University in a positive light, and got to present their work to a panel of judges as well as have opportunities to
