35 Parker-Sedillo, Amber Olichwier, Kyle Tillery, Anthony Trujillo and Eduardo Linares attended the 2018 Agri-
36 Marketing Conference in Kansas City, MO. The NMSU Chapter for the National-Agri Marketing Association will
37 be competing at their national contest. They will be presenting a marketing plan for their product called "Guardian,"

38 which is a horse-monitoring system. This all-encompassing marketing plan requires a wide variety of tasks to
39 complete the final project in order to compete. They are all agricultural economics and agricultural business majors.
40 They will present their final marketing plan to a panel of judges from the agricultural marketing industry that will be
41 acting as the Board of Directors for the company. The NMSU NAMA team will be competing against thirty-two
42 other teams from the United States and Canada.
