

AN ACT

1 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ACCOUNT OF TRIATHLON CLUB NMSU. BE IT ENACTED BY THE  
2 SENATE OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Section 1: Purpose of Act.

5 To provide funding for six students (5 males, 1 female) to compete at the Mountain Collegiate Triathlon Conference  
6 Championship in Lake Havasu, AZ on March 17, 2018.

26 Section 3: Appropriation.

27 One thousand ninety-three dollars and no cents (\$1093.00) shall be appropriated to the account of Triathlon Club  
28 NMSU from the ASNMSU Surplus Account.

30 Section 4: Rationale.

31 Luis Martinez, Taylor Burgett, Mateo Martinez, Brittnee Florez, Allen Love, and Kyle Edgerton of the NMSU  
32 Triathlon Club will be representing NMSU on March 17th, 2018 in the Mountain Collegiate Triathlon Conference  
33 Championship at Lake Havasu City, AZ. At this race the athletes will swim 1 mile, bike for 25 miles and run for 6  
34 miles. Weather conditions during the competition can be harsh at Lake Havasu city with water temperatures being as  
35 low as 60 degrees and land temperatures being as high as 90 degrees. This is a race the team competes in every year  
36 against other collegiate athletes from universities such as, CU Boulder, CSU, NAU, U of A, ASU, Air Force  
37 Academy, BYU, and Wyoming. There is typically close to 200 collegiate athletes that compete at the race and the

NMSU Triathlon Club has placed top 10 in the past. Over the years, as the sport becomes more popular and the athletes become more serious, the race has become more competitive making it harder to place; however, this year the club has talented athletes that hope to be at the top with the best.
