34 Christopher Stanton, Jennifer Byrd, Vanessa Carrillo, Braeden Dimitroff, and Andrea Crawley are requesting  
35 funding to present at the SAA Annual Conference 2018 in Washington, D.C. from April 11-15, 2018. The Society  
36 for American Archaeology (SAA) is the largest professional organization of American archaeologists. Their  
37 presentations cover their research in the wilderness in the Gila National Forest, New Mexico. Their research sheds

38 new light on how the Mimbres peoples of Western and Southwestern New Mexico lived and interacted with their  
39 surrounding environment. Their group was invited by the THEM Forest Service to present their research on work  
40 done during Summer 2017. This conference will also provide them with innumerable opportunities to network with  
41 and meet professionals in their field. Their request includes the 7 nights of hotel accommodations, airfare,  
42 conference registration fee, transportation to and from Las Cruces to El Paso International Airport, parking at El  
43 Paso International Airport, and transportation within Washington, D.C. from their hotel to airport.
