



**A RESOLUTION**

1 CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 8-13-G, 8-13-H, 8-15-V AND 8-16 OF THE 2018-2019  
2 ASNMSU LAW BOOK. BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF ASNMSU.

4 WHEREAS, Recommendations should be a valid motion in the Committee of the Whole; and

6 WHEREAS, Call to previous questions is in order in the Committee of the Whole and can be made only  
7 after discussion on the motion has crossed thirty (30) minutes. Such a motion can either be entertained or  
8 rejected by the chair of the Committee.

10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Associated Students of New Mexico State University that the Rules  
11 of the Senate, as expressed in Chapter 8 of the 2018-2019 ASNMSU Law Book be amended with deleted material in  
12 [brackets] and inserted material underlined as follows:

H. The following motions are in order in the Committee of the Whole to:

1. Adjourn;
2. Appoint, authorize or discharge committees;
3. Take roll call vote;
4. Call for the previous question.

a. The motion to close debate by calling previous question shall follow the procedures laid out in section 8-16.

### **8-15. SPECIAL ORDERS**

...

V. A motion to un-table a piece of legislation from a standing committee and place it on the agenda of the Committee of the Whole shall be in order.

### **8-16. CLOSING DEBATE**

A. When a bill, or resolution has been on the floor for debate for one-half (1/2) hour, it is acceptable and in order, for any Senator to call previous question;

1. When a new motion is created upon the main motion (a debatable secondary motion ([ex.] eg. Amend, Postpone Indefinitely, etc.)), that motion may be debated for one-half (1/2) hour before previous question may be called.
2. After a vote has been taken on the secondary motion, the time will resume on the bill or resolution being discussed.

B. Previous question may not be used in committees, in accordance with the latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order, with the exception of Committee of the Whole.

C. If at any time during the sessions of the Senate a question shall be raised by any Senator as to the presence of a quorum, the presiding officer shall forthwith direct the Chief Senate Clerk to call the roll and shall announce the results.

D. A motion to "call a previous question" shall be followed by a roll call vote.
