A RESOLUTION

1 CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 8-15 OF THE 2018-2019 ASNMSU LAW BOOK.

3 WHEREAS, the ASNMSU senate has adopted the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order as our
4 parliamentary authority; and

6 WHEREAS, in our parliamentary authority there is no defined motion to allow a senator access to the
7 floor if they are late or returning; and

9 WHEREAS, the ASNMSU senate has had a custom of requiring a motion to allow a senator to the floor
10 which is currently an undefined motion and needs to be defined by our Law Book.

12 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Associated Students of New Mexico State University that the
13 following amendments be made to the Rules of the Senate, as expressed in chapter 8 of the 2018-2019 ASNMSU Law Book,
14 with deleted material in [brackets] and inserted material underlined as follows:

24 V. If a Senator is late entering the chambers and misses any roll call a motion to allow will be required for them to
25 enter the chambers.

27 1. This motion is a privileged motion and takes precedence over the main motion, over all subsidiary and
28 incidental motions, and over all privileged motions except those to adjourn and to fix the time which to
29 adjourn;

31 2. It is non-debatable and non-amendable;

33 3. It is out of order when another has the floor;

35 4. Requires a majority vote; and

37 5. Cannot be reconsidered.

6. The general form of this motion shall be as follows: "I move to allow Senator (last name) onto the senate floor."
