31 **7-7-6. RATIONALE**

32 The establishment of a club endowment and a separate club account will prevent ASNMSU from
33 repeating the problems of 1988-89. During that year, clubs were given no direct allocations from
34 the Senate beyond those funds awarded to the college councils in the general appropriations act.
35 By establishing this endowment, ASNMSU will allow for the growth of both base programs and
36 club funding. As the yield grows from the endowment, clubs will have enough funds to [be the
