1 AMENDING SECTIONS 2-3-2 OF THE 2018-2019 ASNMSU LAW BOOK. BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF

[The ASNMSU Attorney General and Deputy Election Officers shall be ex-officio member of the
20 Election Board. In the event that the ASNMSU Attorney General cannot serve, the ASNMSU
21 Deputy Attorney General shall be an ex-officio member of the Election Board. A minimum
22 twenty-four hours (24) hour notice will be given to the Attorney General's office prior to each
23 meeting.]

25 1. The ASNMSU Attorney General shall be ex-officio member of the Election Board.

27 a. In the event that the ASNMSU Attorney General cannot serve, the ASNMSU Deputy
28 Attorney General shall be an ex-officio member of the Election Board. A minimum
29 twenty-four hours (24) hour notice will be given to the Attorney General's office
30 prior to each meeting.
