NMSU VOTING STUDENT REGENT APPLICATION:

Thank you for your interest in serving New Mexico State University as the next Student Regent. The selection process is to take place in Fall 2024 and the Student Regent is expected to serve a two-year term beginning in January 2025. This application is the first step toward becoming a member of the NMSU Board of Regents. The application will be reviewed by members of ASNMSU. The most qualified applicants will be interviewed by a committee which is chaired by the ASNMSU Chief Justice or a designee. The names of the top candidates identified by this committee will be given the opportunity to interview with the NMSU President. The President will determine which applicants will be submitted to the Governor's Office for final approval. The Governor of New Mexico will nominate one person for the position of NMSU voting Student Regent. The nominee will then be subject to confirmation by the New Mexico Senate.

Compensation for the Student Regent will be in the form of the NMSU Leadership scholarship which will require a separate verification process. Other expenses for traveling to and from meetings during the student regent term may be covered.

The most qualified applicants for the position will exhibit exceptional character and commitment to the university and will:

- Have completed at least 60 college credit hours and at least two semesters at New Mexico State University;
- 2. Be currently enrolled in at least 6 credit hours and be in good academic/nonacademic standing;
- 3. Be willing to serve 2 consecutive years and willing to sign a commitment to resign from the position if unable to maintain at least 6 graded credit hours at NMSU each semester during tenure on the Board of Regents; and
- 4. Be willing to attend all scheduled meetings of the NMSU Board of Regents. (Approximately 7 per year.)

Applicants shall complete the attached application and submit this form, along with a letter of interest, and current résumé. The letter of interest may be addressed to the Student Regent Search Committee. The letter should include the applicant's reasons for being interested in the position, their personal view on the role of the Board of Regents, their view on the role of the Student Regent, a description of their experience and involvement at NMSU, and their future plans. Please keep in mind that supplemental materials, such as letters of recommendation, must be submitted with the rest of your application.

The completed application, letter of interest, and current résumé must be submitted no later than **October 31, 2024 at 5:00 PM.** Applications must be submitted digitally by emailing the documents to asnmsu_court@nmsu.edu
