33	The primary purpose of the take care clause is to follow the language located in Article 2, Section 3 of the			
34	United States Constitution, which provides that the President "shall take Care that Laws be faithfully			
35	executed." The primary purpose of this enactment is to affirm that the President's constitutional			
36	responsibility is to ensure that laws enacted by the legislative branch are implemented and enforced. It aims			

37 to enable the executive branch to faithfully and diligently implement the laws of the Associated Students of 38 New Mexico State University. By mandating the faithful execution of the laws, the clause upholds the 39 principle that all duly enacted laws must be observed and enforced. This promotes consistency, order, and 40 adherence to legal norms within the federal system. While the clause requires law enforcement, it also 41 acknowledges that the President and executive agencies maintain some discretion in deciding how laws are 42 enforced, particularly given practical factors such as available resources and enforcement priorities. Finally, 43 the comma amendment in line 26 enhances clarity in the final sentence by separating the main idea from 44 the additional descriptive information, thereby improving clarity.
